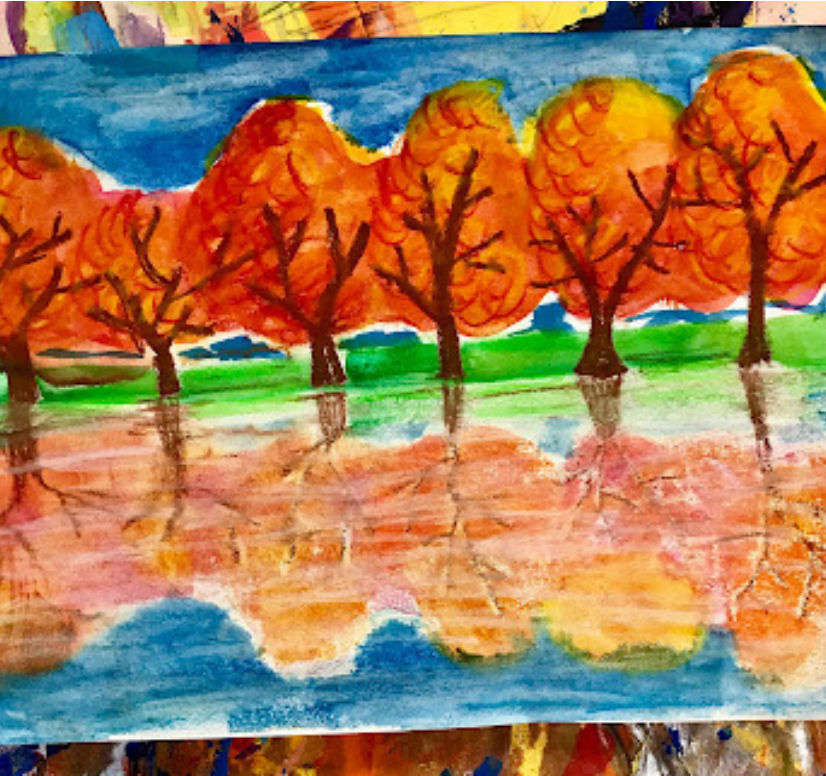

Material List

Thanksgiving Scavenger Hunt: printed pieces, cut up and hidden or actual items hidden; Thanksgiving Scavenger Hunt Master Sheet; pencils; prizes (optional)

Crystal Feathers: Feathers , borax, hot water, access to burner and pot or microwave, mixing spoon

Fall reflection art: watercolor paper, watercolors, oil Pastels, paintbrushes, water rinse cups, paper towels

Group Juggle: 4-5 small balls

Apple slime: Measuring cups, shaving cream, contact solution, red food dye or mica powder, mixing bowl and spoon, apple essential oil, baggies

Oil Pastel Turkey: Watercolor or oil art paper, pencils, oil pastels, eraser or rubber for smearing feathers

Thanksgiving escape room: Escape room copies, lockbox with treats (*don't have a lockbox? No problem! You can hide a bag of treats and create a final clue for where the bag is hidden!*)

Caramel apples: caramel for melting, pot and burner, spoon, toppings (optional), miniature green apples



Fall Camp

Day 1

Game:

Scavenger Hunt: Prep: Hide the cut out pieces around the room(s) and divide kids into teams; each team will get a Master Scavenger Hunt sheet. Tell them not to take the pieces once they find them, but to just mark them off their list and look for the next one.

Project 1:

Crystal Feathers: Using these project directions, boil water and pour into prepared jars with borax. Mix well then submerge feathers. They may lean feathers against the side of the jars overnight. *Crystals may stick to both the side of the jar and to feathers or feathers may stick to one another. That's ok. Just gently peel away once they're crystallized.

Directions:

First draw out "Y" trees on a folded piece of watercolor paper with a brown crayon or oil pastel. You are only working above the folded line for now.



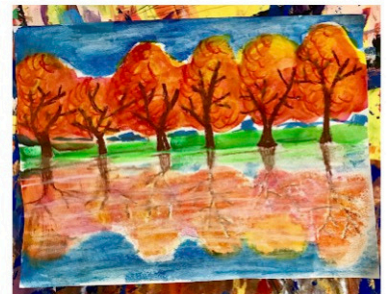
Then, add Fall watercolors to the trees. **Only paint on the top HALF of the folded page.*



After the students paint their trees with warm colors, they add a little bit of blue for the sky, and a strip of green for the ground. With the top half complete, the students are to wet the bottom half of their paper. Add plenty of water to the bottom half or the colors will not transfer. You may have to blot the crease if you have excess water, but that's ok. It's better to have too much, than not enough!

Carefully fold and press the top half over the bottom then lift back up.

When the paint dries, add oil pastel details to make things pop! We'll add leaves, clouds, trunk reflections, and white lines on the bottom half to make it look more like water.

Group Juggle

- Teams of 6-12 stand in a circle & toss a ball in a continuous circuit. Provide these guidelines:
 - Everyone has a turn catching & throwing in the circuit.
 - Do not throw to a person standing beside you.
 - Always throw to same person; always receive from same person.
- Introduce 2nd ball & 3rd ball into mix following same to/from throwing pattern.
- Reflect as a team & make connections.

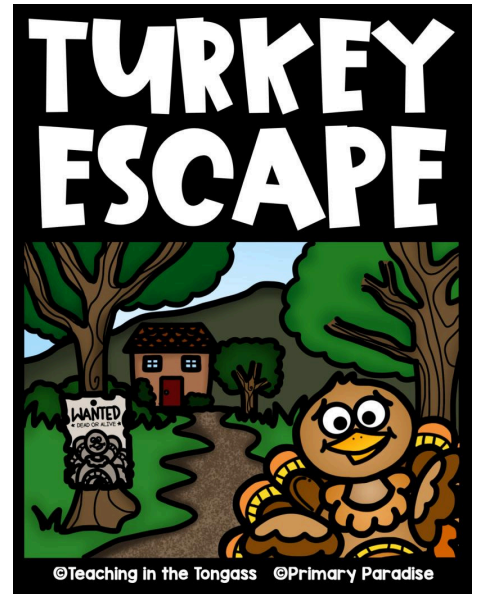

Supplemental Project

Watercolor Leaf Cards

Source: Homemade Heather

Materials:

Watercolor paper cut into 4th's, watercolors, paintbrushes and rinse cups, black crayon or oil pastel, pencil, maple leaf template (optional)



Project modifications:

1. Cut art paper into fourths to make small cards instead of large watercolor paper.
2. Use black crayon, sharpie or oil pastel to trace the leaf instead of black glue.
